

Rules of Safe Conduct and Respect for Hygienic Principles at the Compound of Coca-Cola HBC Česko a Slovensko

I. Rules of safe conduct at the compound of Coca-Cola HBC ČR/SK

- 1. It is forbidden to enter the compound under the influence of alcohol and drugs or to bring in and consume alcoholic beverages or other drugs.
- 2. At the whole compound it is forbidden:
 - a) to smoke (except for places reserved for smoking),
 - b) to use open flame.
- 3. In the event of injury, the participant must immediately contact a Coca-Cola HBC ČR/SK employee who will provide first aid.
- 4. In the event of fire or another emergency situation, evacuation is signalled by a warning siren and radio announcement in such a situation, all participants shall gather outside the lodge and follow the instructions of Coca-Cola HBC ČR/SK employees.
- 5. Each participant is responsible for his/her health and bears exclusive responsibility for the consumption of beverages from the production range of Coca-Cola at the compound of Coca-Cola HBC Česko a Slovensko. Where the participant is allergic to any ingredient of the beverages, is a diabetic or suffers from other health problems that may be worsened by the beverage consumption, the participant is obliged to consider the consumption of beverages from the Coca-Cola production range and Coca-Cola HBC Česko a Slovensko bears no liability for possible health complications in connection with individual health limitations in relation to the consumption of beverages offered at the compound of Coca-Cola HBC Česko a Slovensko.

II. Rules of safe conduct during the tour of bottling lines and warehouses:

- 1. Entry is permitted only to persons over 12 years of age.
- 2. Entry is permitted only to the tour participants:
 - a) wearing sturdy shoes it is forbidden to enter wearing sandals, slippers, high-heeled shoes, ballerina slippers, flip-flops and similar shoes.
 - b) wearing clothes with long trouser legs; women are allowed to wear nylons.

If the participant is not appropriately dressed, he/she will not be taken on the tour of manufacturing lines and warehouses.

- 3. Before entering the manufacturing premises, each tour participant must put on:
 - a) a reflective vest,
 - b) a cap each participant must have all hair covered by a cap.

The reflective vest as well as the cap will be loaned to each tour participant.

- 4. Before entering the manufacturing premises, each tour participant must take off any jewellery (chains, rings, earrings etc.) and keep them on him/her.
- 5. Each participant must have his/her mobile phone hidden in his/her pocket.
- 6. It is forbidden to enter the manufacturing premises and warehouses with food, drinks, chewing gum, sweets etc.
- 7. Handling machines move around the warehouse premises forklifts weighing 3-5 tons; it is therefore necessary to respect the following principles at the premises:
 - a) move in pairs, as the maximum, along the marked pavement,
 - b) before you cross the aisles, always look both ways,
 - c) do not run,
 - d) watch out for the passing forklifts; do not get in their way.
- 8. Machines for the preparation, transport and packaging of beverages, chemicals and equipment for the transport of caps and labels are located at the manufacturing premises. There is a risk of injury caused by contact with the machinery. It is therefore necessary to respect the following principles at the premises:
 - a) do not touch any equipment, conveyors or chemical cans,
 - b) do not crawl under the conveyors,
 - c) do not touch electrical equipment,
 - d) walk slowly and carefully; floors at the manufacturing premises may be wet and there is a risk of slipping.
- 9. Each tour participant must follow:
 - a) instructions of employees attending the tour,
 - b) safety signs, orders and signals.

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III. Tour conditions and cancellation

- Maximum group size is 50 persons including the escort.
- At the whole compound of the factory, it is forbidden to take pictures or videos using cameras, camcorders, mobile phones or other devices.
- A school may cancel the tour a week before it is to take place at the latest, failing which another interested party will be given preference when placing a new order.
- Coca-Cola HBC Česko a Slovensko, s.r.o. reserves the right to cancel the tour for operational reasons at any time without compensation.
